**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDINANCE NO.  
67 PERTAINING TO THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER SKATES, AND  
STREET SKATES**

**THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDAINS:**

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 67:

The amendment title is amended to provide as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF THE USE OF  
SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER SKATES, STREET SKATES, AND MOTORIZED,  
UNLICENSED CONVEYANCES OR SCOOTERS**

**Section 1, Definition** is amended to provide as follows:

For the purpose of this Ordinance, certain items and words are hereby defined

- a.) “Roller Skates and Street Skates” means small wheels near the toe and the heel of shoe or frame that would attach to a shoe which are used for gliding on a hard surface such as a floor, sidewalk, etc.
- b.) “Skateboards” refers to an item consisting of a short, oblong board with small wheels at each end, ridden on a hard surface such as a floor or sidewalk.
- c.) “To roller skate” means to skate on any type of roller skates or street skates.
- d.) “Scooter” or “motorized conveyance” includes any motorized, two-wheeled vehicle not required to be licensed by the State of Michigan.

**Section 8. Scooters and Motorized Conveyance Use Prohibited.**

Use of scooters or motorized conveyances within the Village of Port Austin is prohibited.

**Section 9, Penalties** is amended to provide as follows:

Persons violating this ordinance shall be responsible for a Grade A (Level 1) civil infraction. Each and every day of noncompliance is a separate violation.

**Savings Clause.** If any subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

**Repealer Clause.** All ordinances and or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
