ORDINANCE NO. 39
ANIMAL KEEPING.

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF SWINE, CATTLE,
LIVESTOCK OR FOWL IN THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN**

THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDAINS:

Section I. Prohibited Animals.

No person, firm, corporation or partnership shall keep, house or maintain any swine, cattle, livestock or fowl within the Village of Port Austin, except birds, dogs, cats, or other harmless and domesticated household pets.

Section II. Penalty. (Amended September 23, 2004)

Persons violating this ordinance shall be responsible for a Grade A (Level 1) civil infraction. Each and every day of noncompliance is a separate violation.

Section III. Minor in Violation.

Any police officer who finds a minor violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall procure from such minor his name and address and the name and address of his parents and the minor will then be directed to proceed to his home forthwith. The officer shall then report such violation to the Probate Court for such action as the Court shall deem advisable.

Section IV. Repeal.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section V. Effective Date.

The Ordinance shall take effect twenty-one (21) days after adoption and passage.
