ORDINANCE NO. 50
KEEPING OF DOGS.

**AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE KEEPING OF DOGS
IN THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN**

THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Running at Large.

No dog shall be permitted to run at large in the village of Port Austin at any time, provided however, that dogs may be walked or exercised when they are under restraint, or direct control of the owner or handler, and are prevented from trespassing upon private property not owned by the said dog owner or handler.

Section 2. Disturbing the Peace.

No person owning or boarding any dog shall suffer or permit such dog to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood by barking, howling, or making other loud or unusual noises.

Section 3. Nuisances.

Any dog found in the village running at large and disturbing the peace under conditions set forth in this ordinance is declared to be a nuisance, and shall be impounded by law.

Section 4. Penalties. (Amended September 13, 2004)

Persons violating this ordinance shall be responsible for a Grade B (Level 2) civil infraction. Each and every day of noncompliance is a separate violation.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective May 1st, 1972.
