ORDINANCE NO. 94 - 04

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDINANCE NO. 31,
PERTAINING TO THE PARKING OF TRAILER COACHES IN THE VILLAGE.**

THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDAINS:

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 31:

Section 3, Parking on Dwelling Premises is revised to provide as follows:

Not more than one trailer coach may be parked, used and occupied on the premises of any dwelling as hereinafter limited, provided the occupants of the trailer coach have free access to and the unlimited use of the sanitary facilities of the dwelling on said premises and further provided that such parking, use, or occupancy shall not exceed five (5) days in any one twelve (12) month period.

Section 4, Permits is deleted.

Section 5, Waste Water is revised to provide as follows:

No person shall spill or drain any waste water or liquid waste of any kind from a trailer coach, upon the ground or upon any paved area.

Savings Clause. If any subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Repealer Clause. All ordinances and or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
