ORDINANCE NO. 103 - 04

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDINANCE NO.
76-94 PERTAINING TO THE KEEPING OF CATS.**

THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDAINS:

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 76-94

The ordinance title is amended to provide as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE KEEPING OF CATS;
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.**

Section 3 is amended to provide as follows:

It shall be unlawful to own, possess, shelter, keep, harbor, or maintain a cat or cats under such conditions or in such a manner as to create a nuisance by way of noise, odor, menace to health, or otherwise. The Police Department may destroy any sick, diseased, or abandoned cat or cats which shall be running at large and shall be creating a nuisance by way of noise, odor, menace, or otherwise, and shall maintain a record of same.

Section 5 is hereby abolished.

Section 6 is hereby abolished.

Section 7 is amended to provide as follows:

Persons violating this ordinance shall be responsible for a Grade A (Level 1) civil infraction. Each and every day of noncompliance is a separate violation.

Savings Clause. If any subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Repealer Clause. All ordinances and or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
