**ORDINANCE NO. 85
COMPOST DISPOSAL SITE**

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF THE VILLAGE COMPOST SITE, ESTABLISHED AND MAINTAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN FOR THE DISPOSAL, COMPOSTING, AND RECYCLING OF YARD WASTES.

THE VILLAGE OF PORT AUSTIN ORDAINS:

Section 1.

There is hereby established by this Ordinance a disposal site for the composting and recycling of yard waste.

Section 2.

Yard wastes shall be defined as wastes produced in yards such as grass clippings, leaves, brush, tree limbs and branches which can be converted into humus through biological.

Section 3.

Residents and property owners of the Village of Port Austin may dispose of yard wastes only at the yard waste disposal site at the places and time as shall, from time to time, be established.

Section 4.

No person, firm or corporation shall dispose of any waste except for yard waste as defined herein at the yard waste disposal site. Disposal of garbage, household waste, building materials, metal and all other materials which cannot be converted into humus through biological processes shall be construed as a violation of this section.

Section 5. (Amended September 13, 2004)

Persons violating this ordinance shall be responsible for a Grade C (Level 3) civil infraction. Each and every day of noncompliance is a separate violation.

Section 6.

Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

Section 7.

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty-one (21) days from the date of passage.
